



POLASÁÍ ÚSÁID INGHLACTHA IDIRLÍN

Más rud é go bhfuil difríocht idir a bhfuil scríofa as Gaeilge agus as Béarla sa pholasáí seo, glactar leis an leagan Gaeilge mar an leagan cruinn agus an leagan Béarla mar aistriúchán.

Is é aidhm an Pholasáí Úsáide Inghlactha a chinntiú go bhfaighidh daltaí buntáistí as na deiseanna foghlama as acmhainní idirlín na scoile ar bhealach sábháilte agus éifeachtach. Féachtar ar úsáid agus rochtain idirlíon mar acmhainn agus mar phribhléid scoile. Mura gcomhlíontar polasáí úsáide inghlactha (PÚÍ) na scoile tarraingeofar siar an phribhléid seo.

Tá sé i gceist go ndéanfar athbhreithniú rialta ar an bpolasáí seo go háirithe má thagann aon athruithe nó fadhbanna nua chun cinn.

Stráitéisí na Scoile

Bainfidh an scoil leas as roinnt straitéisí chun cur chomh mór agus is féidir leis na deiseanna foghlama a chuireann an t-idirlíon ar fáil agus chun na baol a bhaineann len' é a úsáid a laghdú. 'Siad seo a leanas na stráitéisí go mbainfear úsáid astu:-

- Beidh múinteoir i gcónaí ag maoirsiú seisiúin idirlín.
- Bainfear leas as bogearraí scagtha agus/nó córais chomhionann chun an baol a bhaineann do nochtadh d'ábhar míchuí a laghdú.
- Déanfaidh na múinteoirí maoirseoireacht rialta ar úsáid idirlín na ndaltaí.
- Cuirfear oiliúint ar fáil do dhaltaí agus do mhúinteoirí maidir le sábháilteacht Idirlín.
- Ní cheadófar íoschóipeáil nó uaslódáil a dhéanamh ar bhogearraí nach mbeidh ceadaithe.
- Bainfear leas as bogearraí cosanta víreas agus déanfar uasdátú orthu go rialta
- Cleachtóidh na daltaí dea-“netiquette” (i.e. etiquette ar an idirlíon) i gcónaí agus ní thabharfaidh siad faoi aon ghníomh a tharraingeoidh droch-cháil orthu féin nó ar an scoil.

An Gréasán Domhanda

- Is chun críocha oideachais amháin a bhainfidh daltaí úsáid as an idirlíon
- Ní rachaidh mic léinn chuig láithreáin idirlín ar a mbeidh ábhair ghraostachta, mídhleathacha, fuatha nó a bheidh míchuí ar bhealach eile.
- Beidh eolas ag daltaí mar is cuí ar cheisteanna cóipchirt a bhaineann le foghlaim ar line.
- Ní dhéanfaidh daltaí nochtadh nó foilsiú ar eolas pearsanta.
- Beidh a fhios ag daltaí gur féidir aon úsáid lena n-áirítear eolas a dháileadh nó a fháil, is Cuma obair scoile nó nithe pearsanta, a bheith faoi mhonatóireacht ó thaobh gníomhaíocht neamhghnách, slándáil, nó cúiseanna bainistíochta gréasáin.

Freagrachtaí an pháiste/dalta

Tá dualgas ar chuide páiste cloí le rialacha na scoile i dtaobh na h-Idirlíne.

- Is pribhléid é don dalta dul ar an idirlíon.
- Is gá ceist a chur ar an múinteoir le dul ar an idirlíon.
- Ní cheart eolas príobháideach a thabhairt amach ar-líne seachas le cead ón múinteoir.
- Níl cead aon ghléas stórála, eochar USB, CD nó DVD a úsáid gan cead an mhúinteora.
- Níl cead féachaint ar aon rud mí-dhleathach a d'fhéadfadh damáiste a dhéanamh do chlú na scoile.
- Má bhristear aon cheann de na rialacha seo beidh smacht bhannaí áirithe i gceist.
- Tá freagracht ar dhaltaí gan mí-úsáid a bhaint as úsáid na h-idirlíne taobh amuigh d'am scoile chomh maith trí theachtaireachtaí míchuí a sheoladh/a sheoladh ar aghaidh ó dhuine go duine, trí rudaí mí-oiriúnacha a chur suas ar na meáin sóisialta srl.
- Fóin póca – Níl cead fón póca dhalta a bheith ar siúl taobh istigh de gheataí na scoile nó ar ghnó scoile.

Freagrachtaí Tuismitheoirí/Caomhnóirí

- Tuiscint nár chóir d'éinne faoi bhun 13 bliana d'aois a bheith cláraithe le leithéidí 'Facebook' agus nach bhfuil úsáid suíomhanna meáin sóisialta ar nós Snapchat, TicToc Instagram srl inmholta do pháistí bunscoile.
- Go dtuigeann gach tuismitheoir go bhfuil baol ag baint lena p(h)áiste a bheith ag baint úsáid as na meáin sóisialta agus go bhfuil feitheoireacht tuismitheora ag teastáil i gcónaí sa bhunscoil má thugtar deis dóibh iad a úsáid.
- Go dtuigeann tuismitheoirí go bhfuil an scoil ag úsáid cosaint cuí maidir le húsáid na hidirlíne ar scoil agus go bhfuil freagracht ar thuismitheoirí cosaint cuí a chur ar fáil maidir le húsáid na hidirlíne taobh amuigh den scoil.
- Go n-aithníonn tuismitheoirí baol cibearbhulaíocht, agus go ndéanfaidh siad gach iarracht freastal ar oícheanta eolais a chuireann an scoil ar fáil maidir leis an ábhar seo.

Cianfhoghlaim

1. Níl cead taifead a dhéanamh nó grianghraf a ghlacadh d'aon sheisiúin beo múinteoireachta.
2. Iarrtar ar an bhfoireann, teaghlaigh agus daltaí meas agus cineáltas a léiriú i gcónaí ar líne.
3. Tá dualgas ar thuismitheoirí/chaomhnóirí feitheoireacht a dhéanamh ar na páistí agus iad ar líne.
4. Beidh foireann an scoile i dteagmháil le teaghlaigh na scoile tríd Aladdin agus Zoom.
5. Beidh gach cumarsáid tríd na bealaí seo ann ar son oideachais an bpáistí agus chun cumarsáid a dhéanamh leis na teaghlaigh faoin oideachas.
6. Tá cead tuismitheora intuigthe do na rangann Zoom má tá an páiste ag freastal ar an seisiún toisc go seoltar an nasc chuig seoladh teaghlaigh.
7. Leantar gnáth polasaithe, rialacha agus nósanna scoile i rith an tréimhse cianfhoghlama.

POLICY ON ACCEPTABLE USE OF THE INTERNET

Should there be any discrepancy between the Irish and English in this policy, it is accepted that the Irish is the correct version and the English is provided as a translation.

The aim of this Acceptable Use Policy is to ensure that pupils will benefit from learning opportunities offered by the school's Internet resources in a safe and effective manner. Internet use and access is considered a school resource and privilege. If the school's Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) is not adhered to this privilege will be withdrawn.

It is envisaged that the school will revise the AUP on a regular basis especially as the internet changes and develops and new implementation issues arise.

School's Strategies

The school will employ a number of strategies in order to maximise learning opportunities and reduce risks associated with the Internet. These strategies are as follows:-

- *Internet sessions will always be supervised by a teacher.*
- *Filtering software and/or equivalent systems will be used in order to minimise the risk of exposure to inappropriate material.*
- *The teachers will monitor pupils' Internet usage.*
- *Students and teachers will be provided with information/training in the area of Internet safety.*
- *Uploading and downloading of non-approval software will not be permitted.*
- *Virus protection software will be used and updated on a regular basis.*
- *Students will observe good "netiquette" (i.e. etiquette on the Internet) at all times and will not undertake any actions that may bring the school or themselves into disrepute.*

World wide web

- *Students will use the Internet for educational purposes only.*
- *Students will not visit Internet sites that contain obscene, illegal, hateful or otherwise objectional materials.*
- *Students will be familiar with copyright issues relating to online learning.*
- *Students will never disclose or publicise personal information.*
- *Students will be aware that any usage, including distributing or receiving information, school related or personal, may be monitored for unusual activity, security and/or network management reasons.*

Children's/Pupil's Responsibilities

Every child in the school has a responsibility to follow the school's Use of Internet Rules:

- *It is a privilege for a child to be allowed use the Internet.*
- *The teacher must give permission for the Internet to be used.*
- *No private details may be given in any form online unless with the approval of the teacher.*
- *No personal storage, USB devices, CDs or DVDs may be used without the permission of the teacher.*
- *Children may not look at any illegal material that could damage the school's reputation.*
- *Sanctions will be imposed should any of the above rules be broken.*
- *Pupils have a responsibility to behave appropriately online outside of school time also by not sending inappropriate messages/not sending on to others inappropriate message they may have received, through not putting inappropriate material on social media etc.*
- *No pupil may have their mobile phone switched on when on school grounds or on school business.*

Parents' Responsibilities

- *To understand that no child under the age of 13 should have a Facebook account or similar and that the unsupervised use of social media sites such as Snapchat, TicToc, Instagram etc is not advisable for children of primary school going age.*
- *Each parent/guardian should be aware that there may be risks and dangers associated with their child using forms of social media and that parental supervision is required in this area.*
- *That parents acknowledge the school has safeguards in place with regard to pupil internet/website access at school and that use outside school falls under parental responsibility.*
- *The parents acknowledge the dangers of cyberbullying and undertake to avail where possible of any information evenings organised by the school.*

Remote Learning

1. *Under no circumstances should pictures or recordings be taken of video calls.*
2. *Staff, families and students are expected to behave in an appropriate, safe, respectful and kind manner online. All online communication should adhere to these guidelines.*
3. *It is the duty of parents/guardians to supervise children while they are working online and to ensure that any content submitted to their teacher is appropriate.*
4. *Staff members will communicate with pupils and their families via Aladdin and Zoom.*

5. Any electronic forms of communication will be for educational purposes and to allow for communication with families.
6. For video/Zoom calls, parental permission is implied, as the link to a video call will be communicated via the parent/guardian's email address. Essentially, by virtue of the pupil logging on to the call, permission is assumed.
7. Normal school policies, rules and procedures apply during period of remote learning.
8. Gaelscoil na Fuinseoige cannot accept responsibility for the security of online platforms, in the event that they are compromised.


Sanctions
